Because of the peril would-be travelers often faced when attempting to traverse the Unknown Regions, the region eventually earned the moniker “The Chaos.” But this didn’t deter the Chiss, who were determined to find greener pastures following a period of climatic disaster on their homeworld, Csilla. This led to the use of rare Force-sensitive Chiss to navigate the dangerous hyperspace conditions of the Unknown Regions. These ancient Chiss navigators were eventually given the name “ozyly-esehembo”, which meant “Sky-Walkers” in Cheunh. One collection of stars that seemingly called out to these Sky-Walkers, helping point their way to less dangerous paths leading to other worlds within and without the Unknown Regions, was a grouping that would eventually be named after a species known to inhabit tropical planets the galaxy over: the Convor.
