Coruscant: Club Kasakar

[Anakin](http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Anakin_Skywalker) once visited [Coruscant's](<http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Coruscant>) underbelly, as an escort for [Supreme Chancellor Palpatine](http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Darth_Sidious)'s secret visit. Festering within the 2685th level of Coruscant, it is a feeding ground to the best and worst criminals—bureaucrats among them. Slaves and contraband are bought and sold on the hour, while others gamble with their lives or ill-gotten gains on the roll of a chance cube.

Others are content to seek entertainment, watching holographic projections of exotic dancers in various states of undress—the likes of which will no doubt be traded as slaves in exchange for credits or other services. Games of chance are often obscured under the sheer volume of patrons gathered around the game tables. Smaller round tables serve for social or business gatherings, with more discreet booths tucked into alcoves along the walls.

Having undergone unfinished renovations at some point, the ceiling has been raised to resemble that of a warehouse. Smoke gathers among the durasteel supports, making a buffer for the intense red and violet beams lighting the cesspit below. Zeltron perfumes are among the most common smells in the establishment, while the rolling of dice cubes make for the most recognizable sound above the music. Fights don't often break out, and violence is often dissuaded at the sight of armoured bouncers several heads taller than most humanoids.

Dagobah: Cave of Evil

On a quest to learn the path to [eternal consciousness](http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Force_spirit), [Yoda](<http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Yoda>) once encountered a dark-side infested cave that

later served as a part of [Luke Skywalker's](http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Luke_Skywalker) training. Beneath a [gnarl tree](http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Gnarl_tree) on [Dagobah](<http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Dagobah>), the hollow manifests apparitions of a dark future to its visitors. Its influence can overwhelm even the most learned Force-users, creating illusions that trick or deceive those who enter it. The surrounding swamps echo the dark energies at its heart, devoid of living creatures too anxious to stalk nearer to the hollow. Inside, the cave itself is as one might expect—unremarkable walls and tangled masses of roots dangling from a low ceiling. However, some who have braved the darkness claim to have been taken elsewhere, leaving their corporeal bodies behind while being shown nightmares of things to come.

Tatooine: Jawa Sandcrawler

Treading the harsh desert sands of [Tatooine](<http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Tatooine>) are the sandcrawlers. A mobile fortress used by [Jawa](<https://www.google.com/url?q=http%3A%2F%2Fstarwars.wikia.com%2Fwiki%2FJawa>) scavengers, the vehicle drives on large treaded wheels and functions as transportation for scavengers, as well as shelter from the harsh desert environment. Boasting cargo holds, scrap processing facilities and quarters for crew and passengers, there is room enough to fit an entire Jawa clan.

Tall and mostly rectangular, the sandcrawler's triangular front allows the cockpit to be positioned well above the dunes. From this vantage, the Jawa clan calling this sandcrawler home is able to detect treasure troves of another's discarded junk. Magnetic suction tubes allow the Jawas to quickly suck [droids](<https://www.google.com/url?q=http%3A%2F%2Fstarwars.wikia.com%2Fwiki%2FDroid>) and pieces of scrap into the holds. Worthless trinkets and metal scraps can be melted down from the heat of the onboard reactor.

Bahryn: Beneath the Surface

Resembling a ball of ice, [Bahryn](<http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Bahryn>) is a frozen moon over [Geonosis](<http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/Geonosis>) with a thin outer crust resting atop pillars of ice. Beneath the outer sheet of ice, the entire moon resembles a dark cavern not

much warmer than the surface, which is buffeted by constant winds. Elegant, as if carved in a decorative fashion, the thin pillars holding up the outer ice sheet lead to a vaulted ceiling with no exit aside from a hole several meters in diameter.

Even without the extreme winds rushing above the surface, the cold is enough to kill most survivors in a matter of hours. Glowing rocks scattered beneath the crust are all that gives out light or heat in the darkest recesses. Besides of the amber glow of the meteorite fragments, light also streams in through the hole above. Although rare, old shuttles are known to have crashed through the ice sheet into the cavern that might contain additional supplies, or a means to call for aid to those stranded.

Shrill cries reverberate between the frozen surfaces, originating from the native [bonzami](<http://starwars.wikia.com/wiki/bonzami>)—massive four-legged creatures that almost stand tall enough to brush the outer crust. Horned mouths, white fur and plated spines allow these beasts protection from both intruders and the elements while they roam in packs, attracted by heat sources.
