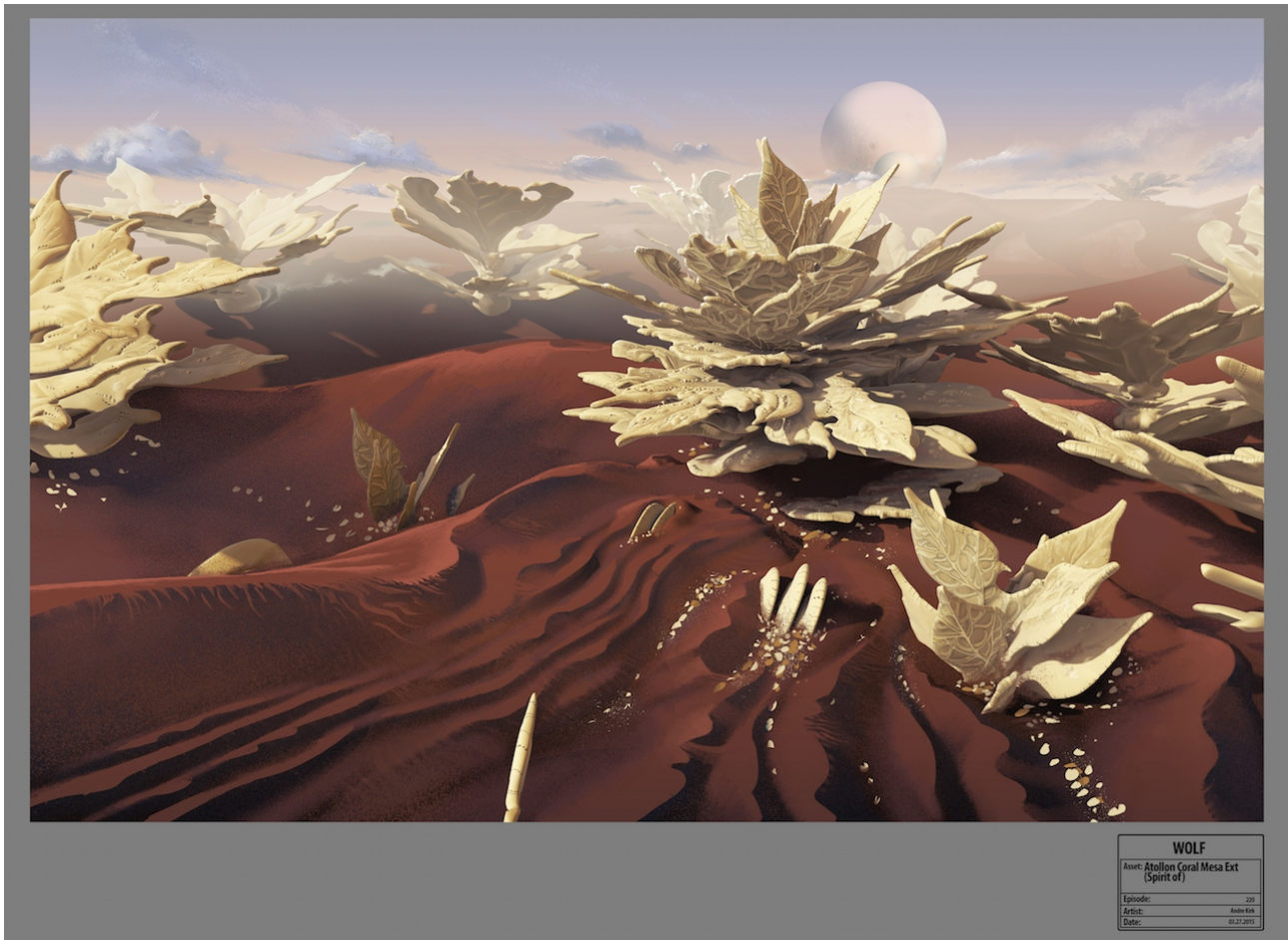


## Atollon: Coral Mesa / Chopper Base



Bordered by a major hyperspace route the isolated world known as Atollon doesn't stand out much of the crowd of desert world in the known Galaxy. Looking suspiciously inhospitable the planets surface is mostly covered by reddish sandbanks, only the keen eye will notice the huge coralline formations. The corals itself where shot by caves that dig deep underground where pools of fresh water that nourishes the local fauna and flora and serves as hive to the planets most dominant predators, the giant, spider-like krykna.

There isn't much known about the remote planet except the inside of the caves were confirmed to sport a much more comfortable climate compared to the surface with its hot and dry weather that can be simply described as unpleasant.
