

Shattered Ties Battleplan

Current Situation:

The Scholae Palatinae forces have taken control of the base. A cache of artifacts is under our possession. Red Fury Pirate forces are in full retreat. Stragglers of the remaining red fury pirates are coming through the base from deep within, unknown of intentions of reclamation or retreat. Enemy Naga Sadowan Forces are advancing through the entrance of the base.

Forces:

Friendly Forces:

- 6 Dark Jedi
- 240 Soldiers of the Imperial Scholae Guard
- 40 Members of the Scholae Expeditionary Force

Enemy Forces:

Naga Sadow:

- 6 Dark Jedi
- 300 Sadowan Warhost Infantry

Red Fury:

- Unknown, Estimated at approximately 20-35 Red Fury pirates still within the base

Objective:

Option One:

The primary goal of the team is to get a safe and efficient extraction out of the base from the enemy forces. The objective of securing and safely transporting the cache of artifacts needs to be completed along with the survival of our forces. We need to hold the base long enough to safely extract the artifacts as well as keep the extraction zone secure for our own extraction.

Alternative:

The primary objective is the safe extraction of all artifacts and any associated documentation or research. In order to accomplish this, any remaining Red Fury pirates will need

to be eliminated to ensure we have full control over the base. We must also set up a secure defensive position to enable the extraction of the artifacts to proceed unhindered by the Sadowan forces. Survival of our troops is secondary to claiming the artifacts, however losses will need to be kept to a minimum in order to provide an effective defense of our position.

Unit Placement:

Splitting up is never a good tactic, but it will need to be done in order to secure the artifacts and safely extract our forces from the base.

1. The first team will be comprised of two squads of 5 soldiers each to load up the transports with two Dark Jedi to oversee the process of moving artifacts and their priority due to importance.
2. A second team will be comprised of the platoon of forty Expeditionary Force soldiers accompanied by a pair of two Dark Jedi to snuff out any red fury pirates that are rumored to be deep within the base. This team will be predominantly autonomous within the confines of their mission, as the location of remaining Red Fury forces is still unknown within the base.
3. The remaining forces will be tasked with holding the line to prevent Naga Sadow forces from taking control of the base and securing the artifacts.

Plan of Execution:

The main course of action is to have team one load the artifacts on the transports as best as it can be done. It will be prioritized based on importance and size however, we will attempt to extract all artifacts that we possibly can. Team two will move into the depths of the base to deal with or route out the remaining Red Fury pirate forces that are straggling behind from the initial takeover of the base. Team three is crucial because they are the majority of our remaining forces and the team that has to hold the line from Naga Sadow. They need to prevent their advance as long as possible for the other two teams to be successful with their missions. They will be posted in a defensive formation in the corridors of the base entrance. Multiple lines of defense will be placed down the corridors until the final line is the extraction zone. Each line will be comprised of approximately a squad on each side of the corridor so that there are no flanks or blind spots that could be fired upon. The advantage will be in our favor because CNS forces will have to advance into the corridors to engage defensive forces. They will be positioned in series down the halls which will be crucial. This is a good defensive tactic because when the line is broken, another squad can cover their retreat and providing for support on the new line of defense.

Once team one is completed with moving the artifacts, the remaining teams two and three will move back to the extraction point and take the shuttles out of the base safely with a

completed mission. Each team will move in series just like the defensive line, covering each line of soldiers as the front firing squad that is defending is covered for and accountable. The last line of defense before the extraction is the last line of defense that would have been defending from the enemy. The least amount of lines breached, everyone should and is expected to go home. Squads from team one will provide cover for the extraction process of teams two and three when the artifacts are secured.

Contingency:

In the event where a contingency plan will be necessary, the success of the mission lies with the success of the operation. If the base is overrun with the enemy with all our forces killed and no artifacts recovered, then the mission was a waste of time and we failed. Being that team one is prioritizing the artifacts, we know we will go home with something. Team Two will retreat back to the extraction point, leaving the remaining red fury pirates. The extraction zone will be important so team two will move to the extraction zone to provide as much support as possible and cover for retreating team one members. Team one will retreat in a series of defensive lines in order to cover for each other. It will be a retreat in several steps where the forward most line retreats while the next line covers for them and they move in succession to the next line until the extraction point. By then, teams one and two will be able to grant some time to allow for cover and support. Once everyone is secure we leave, hopefully, although we do not have all the artifacts, we have the ones that were prioritized in its importance.
