Due to the ongoing battle, your nephew was not found in very good condition. He had been successfully extracted from the battlefield; however, he had suffered major injuries to his right leg and arm. These injuries eventually led to him passing away due to loss of too much blood before he could be stabilized.

We realize that your nephew was a practicing force user, and have extended our support out to our units nearest to you. We sincerely hope that they can not only soothe your worries, but also help deliver you to a more comfortable location to grieve. They will be bringing along what few items Rulvak left behind.

In this time of sorrow, we share your grief. It is extremely unfortunate that we could not treat him quickly enough to stop the bleeding and help him recover, which might have led to him coming home to recuperate. It would have been very beneficial for him to have seen you again before he passed away.

We sincerely hope that you will find comfort in the fact that we have given your nephew full military honors and rites at the funeral. All our fallen comrades are treated with the utmost respect. We are sorry for your loss.
