Physical: Standing at 5'7" and weighing in at 143lbs, she could pass off as your average near-human woman. Jet-black hair kept medium-short and cut into feathered layers with bangs swept to the side, and piercing amber colored eyes - hinting at Pantoran heritage, combined with soft feminine features make Helen Beck a striking woman. But her beauty belies a hardline, no nonsense, military commander.

Orphaned at a young age, She lacks the tattoo signifying her Kiffar parentage. Instead, she has chosen to show her allegiance to Taldryan by boldly wearing a tattoo on her chest reflecting her former role in its 1st Battalion / 1st Company.

Several scars from past battles adorn her face. One starting just at the end of her hairline, it almost perfectly traces her right cheekbone. Another, a small diagonal scar that starts just above her earlobe and ends just shy of her jawline.

History: Born on Karufr to Kiffar parents, but orphaned early on, Helen Beck joined the *Early Enrollment* program of the Karufr Military Academy. Her time in the academy was mostly unremarkable save for a disciplinary track record, including, instigating several catina brawls,

beating 2 fellow cadets to near death with a hydrospanner, and breaking the arm of a commanding officer. Though she was never officially reprimanded.

After graduation Helen Beck was placed in the 101st, an event commemorated by her new family with bold tattoos. Despite her rocky start, Helen Beck turned out to be exemplary soldier. Although she did have a knack for disobeying orders, further review by the TDF war council has often times noted that her disobedience has led to critical mission success and minimal casualties.

Before the sacking of Karufr by Grand Master Jac Cantor, Lieutenant Beck had blazed through the ranks of the TDF and was an important figure in the 101st. On that fateful day however, many senior officers lost their lives and Beck was given full command a day later.

When Quaestor Justinios Drake gave birth to the SRI, it needed a military attachment, Helen Beck was approached to assume command of the new Battalion. Reluctant to leave the 101st behind, she turned the Aleena down multiple times before being made an offer she couldn't refuse. The battalion, under her command, would fall outside of the Grand Legion of Taldryan and under direct control by the Jedi of Taldryan.
