Regarding the composition of the S.R.I. forces.

Due to the nature of the Sphere of Research and Intelligence's operations, it is in our best interest to gather only the best and brightest from within the Taldryan Defense Force and to repurpose them into roles vital to mission success.

With the battalion falling outside of the standard military structure, individual units are expected to act independently and efficiently in foreign, and often hostile, environments. A Drop Company is a key component in any unit intent on succeeding at forays in unknown territory. Their expertise in survival and a multitude of environments allows the SRI to deploy such a detachment in advance to destabilize enemy infrastructure.

For further support, a Scout Company supported by BARC-speeders and ULAVs allows for rapid strikes and long-range termination of enemy assets.

In case such hit-and-run tactics fail, deployment of armored operations, supported by 2-M Hover Tanks, AT-TEs, and First Order AT-AT Platoons, can devastate those unprepared to deal with overzealous fire power. If all else fails, reducing the enemy to rubble can be a viable option. Even if we do not deploy such forces, they can be reassigned to defending forward command posts, or even the S.R.I. Headquarters.

To cap off, a Special Missions Company supported by an APC squadron will serve as the elite of the elite. Rapid deployment capabilities, flexibility, and unconventional warfare suit the S.R.I. mission statement, and such forces can be deployed to act independent of the mainline S.R.I. forces, or to work in support of our field agents.

The S.R.I.s black ops and wet work expertise will also provide a boost to Taldryan's main forces during times of war where they will work side-by-side with the Grand Legion and Taldryan's Jedi Forces.
