

## Location 1:

Name: The Transport Receiving and Departing Station A [West] and B [North]

Description: The Transport Receiving and Departing Station A [West] and B [North] is the embarking and disembarking station for much of Hoth main base located in a mountain just a few kilometers away from where the main hub of Hoth lies deep underground. Within the stations, there are larger compartments beneath the surface with reinforced walls, floors, and ceilings where the large ships are housed, routinely assessed during maintenance, and eventual launch for missions related to the Clan and House.

The landing strip which leads into the cave entrance for these ships jets out from the mountain with support beams that may relax downwards so that the large half surfaces may be hidden from potential enemies. The cave entrance largely stays closed unless a ship has reported a need for docking or if there is a scheduled disembarking for supplies. The initial part of the cave where the ship lands involve a segment for inspection by Hoth crew members for each ship coming in. There are two internal stations in this part that involves the ships being attached to diagnostic computers after each flight and the more tedious inspection by hand of the crew of the inside and outside of each vehicle. From this section of the cave, there is a tunnel which is consistently large enough to allow for a multitude of ships to pass through to the large lift. This lift allows the larger ships to be organized and stored for the next launch as a means to protect assets and allow for Hoth to maintain secrecy from potential enemies. Offset from this tunnel is where the crew of the ships and the crew members who take routine shifts go with a much smaller lift to a large, two floor living arrangement.

Within these living arrangements, there is a floor dedicated to more homely amenities such as a series of beds, storage for supplies, additional storage for food and water, and entertainment for those who require some breaks from their shifts when they are tasked with ship maintenance. The second floor involves more intricate supplies involved with ship maintenance and also another part of this floor has a stash of battle ready weapons which are to be inspected regularly as well.

The lift that reaches those floors is able to extend further into the planet where it stops just at a small line of shuttle trains that take crew members as well as supplies to the main Hoth base hub. Each shuttle train has a number of carts that allows for a range of supplies like weapons, materials, food, water, etc. that may be needed within the main hub. The [West] station usually brings in more specific supplies as it is closer to the part of the surface leading to other parts of the planet. The [North] station tends to bring more supplies from the actual Trepus land mass with the additional need for emergency launches with Hoth members coming from this point as well. The [West] point can be used as well for emergency launches, but these usually involve the supply of weapons and fighters to the

battlefield rather than to other parts of the planet or space if needed. The [North] station is also considerable bigger than the [West] as it is able to check four ships at a time and house more ships than the [West] station.
