==Business==

Lorahx Engineering Solutions (LES) is an engineering, repair, and reclamation shop in the [[Eldar]] capital city of [[Shihon]], created in the immediate aftermath of the initial reinvestment of the planet by [[Arcona]] and, more specifically, [[House Galeres]]. The business was founded by Lorahx Tist, a Keadan freed from the pirates and slavers that had been ravaging the planet in the post-plague devastation.

===Services===

The shop, situated in the desert-bound city of [[Shihon]], is definitively lacking in resources. With the fall of organized civilization on Eldar following the plague that crippled the population's numbers, the flow of goods into the capital are far and few between. However, with the nigh forced attempt at revitalization, the shop provides a number of essential services to the locals and to the Arconan overlords.

First and foremost, LES is a repair shop. Its strategic location near the municipal spaceport gives Lorahx ready access to all manner of vehicles to tend to, from starships to speeders. This earns the store credits in some cases, refurbishable parts in others, or sometimes simply subsistence supplies. Most starship repairs are done at the starport itself, though at times it is more expedient or cost effective to bring the broken part to the shop.

The repair and engineering services extend to the local provisional government, largely supervised by the [[DDF|Dajorra Defense Force]], where Lorahx conducts surveys and repairs

on Shihon's neglected infrastructure. This largely focuses on the pumps that keep the city supplied with fresh water from the massive subterranean reservoirs, though on occasion he is contracted for work on the monorails and powerplants that require extensive long-term work.

This working relationship has led to Lorahx, and LES as a store, to be given license by the provisional government (and by extension, Galeres) to salvage designated scrap, parts, and systems. It is not uncommon for the proprietor to "hire" local children to run messages or haul parts in pursuit of this venture, who will usually tip him off to more salvage for the return employment in a strange sort of symbiotic relationship. The salvage is then reclaimed or repurposed so that, while it may not be as good as new, it is returned to being fully functional.

Thus the work cycle comes full circle, repairing vehicles and systems with these reclaimed parts.

===Location & Description===

LES is situated at one of the major intersections of the Diamond Quarter, just outside of the boundaries of Supresa Spaceport proper. Once a two-story home, the building was repurposed and, in the wake of the brief battle for Shihon, repaired to keep out the elements and thieves. The lower floor was opened up (by knocking down room-dividing walls) into a workshop and general storage area, while the upper floor serves as the actual living quarters.

The exterior of the shop has retained much of its original decor: sandstone-brick walls, with a few awnings over the door or overhanging the dual-purpose roof/patio. The major change to the building's facade came in the form of the large shutter door that allows not only vehicles needing repair to come and go, but also for easy intake of supplies which, when not moved by hand, are loaded onto Lorahx's large hover-dolly.

Inside, the workshop area is **mostly** well-organized, with larger parts set against the wall where the handful of shelves are either too small or too weak to hold them. A fair-sized space behind the shutter door always remains vacant for the next vehicle (or large ship part, if delivered) that will inexorably come in. Few decorations line the walls, their place instead held by tools both powered and manual. Sometimes a good whack with a hammer is more valuable than a hydrospanner.

Upstairs, Lorahx's quarters comprise a modest one-room flat. His bed is the same mattress that inhabited the house before he moved in; the rest were sold off or bartered with other freed Eldar residents for parts, food, and other niceties. Some decoration in the form of woven blankets and worn out rugs adorn the walls and floor respectively. Despite that everything is recycled property of some dead former resident of Shihon, the apartment is kept clean and orderly, with a small central table where he eats dinner, prepared at the equally small kitchen. Another chair sits outside the rooftop door, where Lorahx is known to spend his leisure time, watching the horizon, enjoying the sun and breeze.

==Personnel==

****Lorahx Tist**** is the only person operating his shop. A middle aged Keadean male, he sports many of the same characteristics of others of his races: scaly, olive-brown skin, with a komodine snout and a collection of loose skin hanging from his chin down his throat. His scalp is spotted by a turf of soft, grass-like feathers, which match in color the longer strands of feather-mustache that reach just below his chin.

Given his profession, his strength is that built up by manual labor and, given the current infrastructure situation on Eldar, copious walking. This matches his short, stocky frame well, which has many times permitted him to fit into small places to access the various pieces of machinery that he is employed to repair. Because of this, he dresses in simple clothes, usually spotted with dirt or machine oil around the cuffs and sleeves, even in the few pieces of more traditional Keadean clothing that he's managed to retain.

In demeanor, Lorahx would be considered by some "old before his time." He takes little pleasure in frivolities, instead usually enjoying his work where he can, and solitary peace and quiet during his moments of free time. Amiable and to-the-point, he often avoids pleasantries that get in the way of expedient delivery of words, ideas, or anything else for that matter. While not a family-oriented person, and occasionally employing child labor, he quietly contributes to the community vicariously through his underage workers: none are ever placed in any dangerous or precarious position, and the wages they reap more often than not go to their families. Further, while he understands that the orders come from the Dajorran military, he takes a certain serious pride in the work he does on revitalizing the workings in the belly of Shihon.
