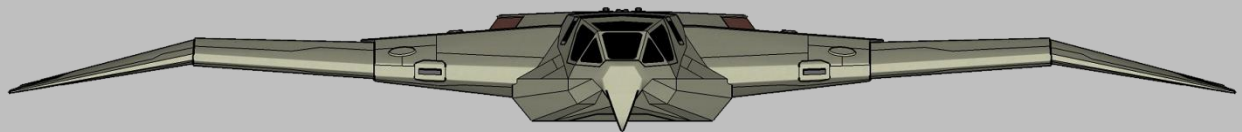

This is my rendition of my absolute favorite ship—the Sith WarHawk. For the apparent reason, this ship fits DarkHawk. Me being an old duffer, this is from the TV Series *Buck Rogers in the 25th Century*¹. All I have done here is took the two stock pictures and traced them out on my Wacom tablet into both Photoshop and Lightroom. Then did color overlays/masks to get the color I wanted. I initially wanted black with the red, but the black saturated the natural lines of the ship, so I went with the darker grey. I also used a stock earth photo to create the backdrop for the ship

The coolest part of this fighter is that the wings are telescoping. Much like the design of the USN F-14E Strike Eagle's sweep wings. The two outer sections of wings retract into the mainframe of the ship. This design is solely for dogfighting. With the wings retracted, you have less restriction and gives it more agility during a dogfight.

The Sith WarHawk is a prestigious fighter, like many other ships used, obtaining a WarHawk is considered an honor. In the hands of an adept pilot, this fighter takes the fight to the skies with devastating effectiveness.
