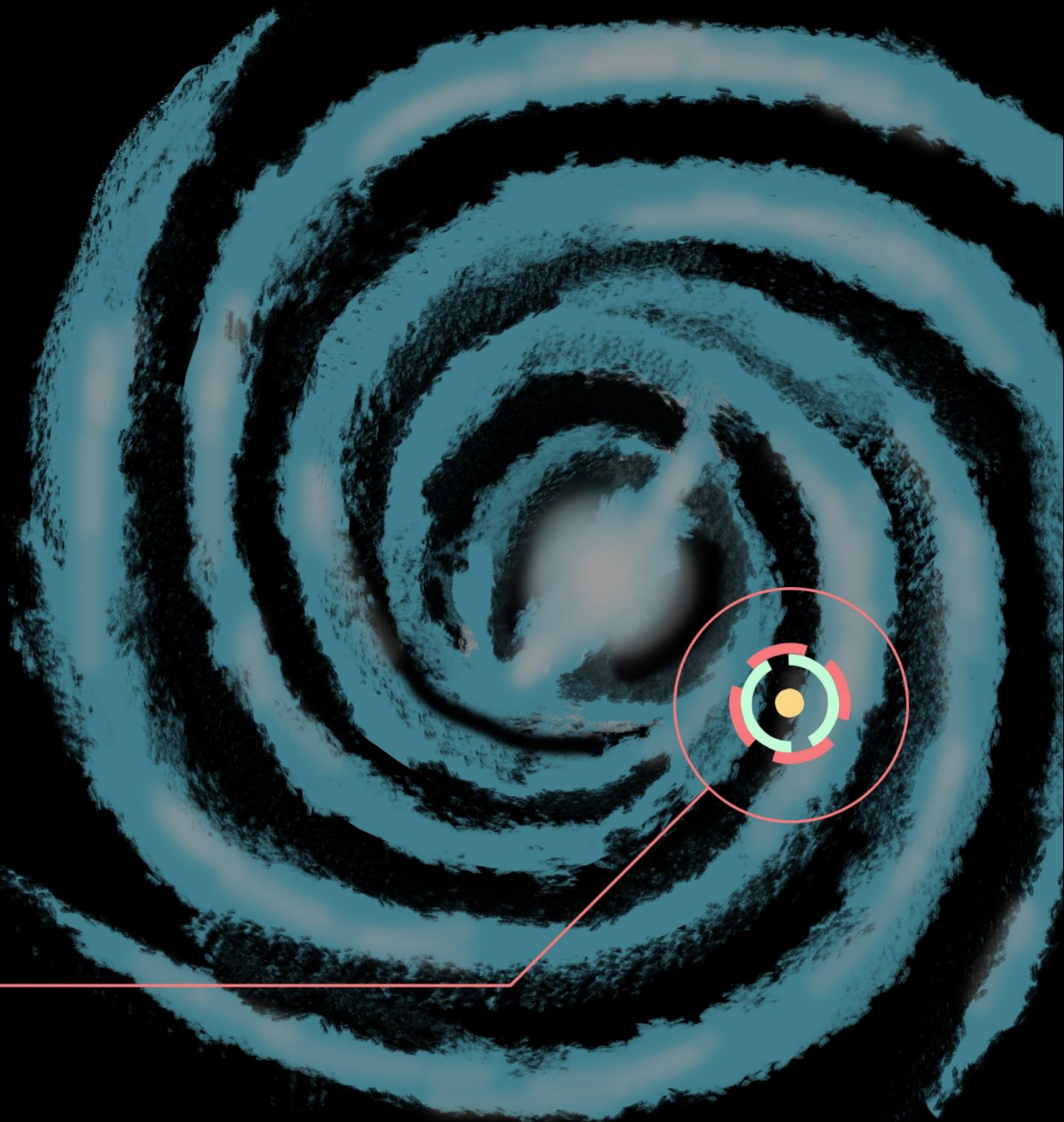
OPERATION: “HELLO THERE”

CULARIN SYSTEM

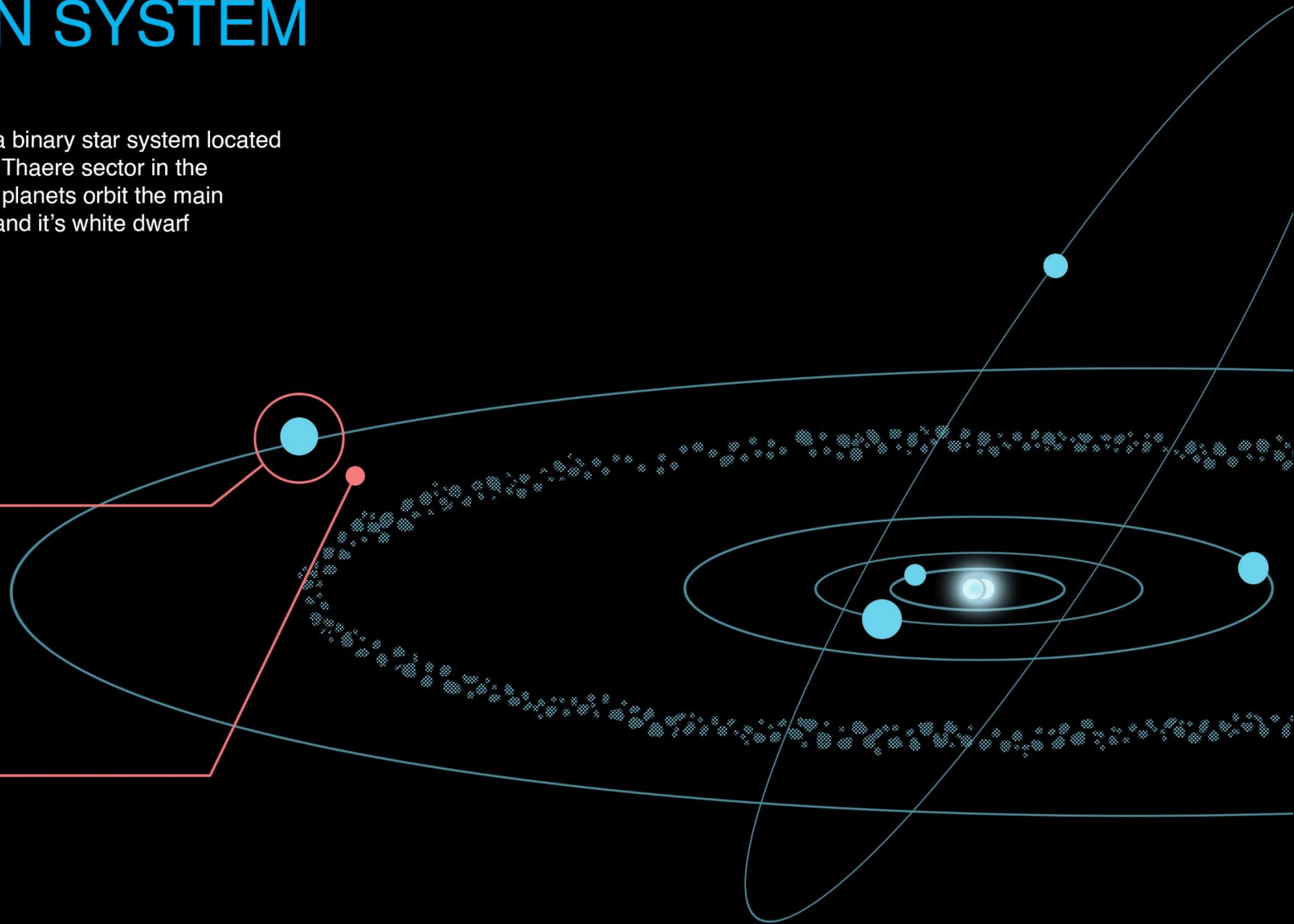


CULARIN SYSTEM

Sitting near the outer edge of the habitable zone, the once molten terrestrial planet was terraformed using kaluthin grass that absorbed the phosphorus and methane and converted it to breathable air, although a breath mask is still required. The phosphorus that remained in the leaves cast a faint glow giving the planet a faint “aurora.”

Additionally the massive taproots stretching deep into the ground help to channel heat to the surface, thus warming the atmosphere. Lacking any surface water, early inhabitants used massive wells to tap into the abundant underground aquifers of clean, crystal clear water.



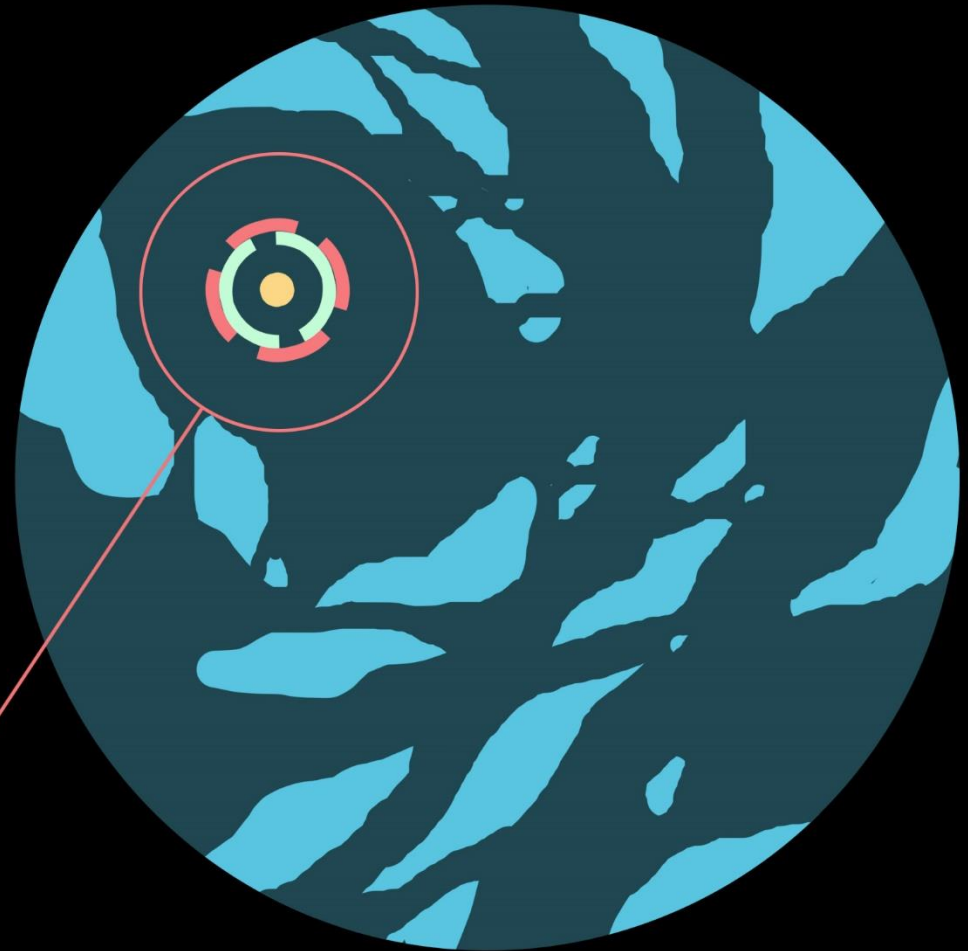

A planet that once orbited closer to the suns, Dorumaa at one time crossed orbits with Orblis, another planet in the system. Once Orblis was destroyed by the Darkstaff in 1000 BBY creating the Cularin Asteroid belt. This resulted in Dorumaa being flung farther out into the system before being captured by Almas gravity and finally resting in its current location. Being so far from the central stars, the newly reclassified “moon” froze.

Around 47 BBY the Dorumaa Investment Group, a consortium of anonymous shareholders, began investing in the terraforming of Dorumaa in order to repurpose it as an oceanic resort world consisting of various island resort locations. In addition to stabilizing the atmosphere, terraforming efforts also spawned a multitude of aquatic life, many of which are popular tourist attractions while some of the more “accident prone” live well below the surface.

D.I.G UNDERWATER RESEARCH FACILITY



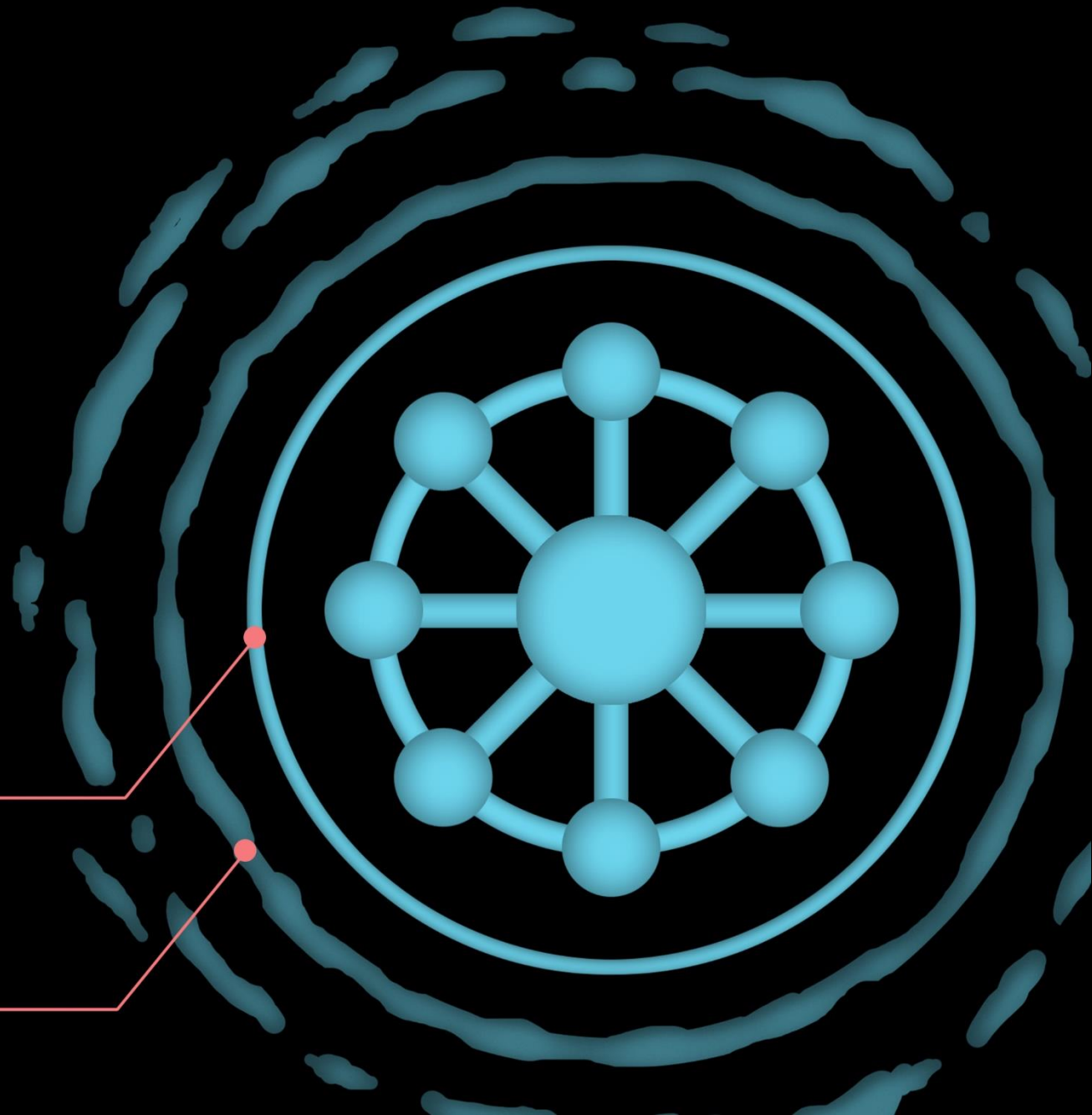
D.I.G UNDERWATER RESEARCH FACILITY

Intelligence reports indicate the Dorumaa Investment Group along with the Perlemian Cartel, owns and operates a research facility 1 kilometer underneath the ocean world's surface. Originally thought to be the home of breeding labs for the various creatures needed during the terraforming efforts, the sustained natural breeding of the animals has thus rendered this facility unnecessary, however it remains fully operational.

High orbital scans show the facility is fairly large in surface area though only containing a single level. It consists of a circular central hub with eight smaller hubs surrounding it, all connected by various corridors as seen in the picture. Each outer hub has watertight hatches for personnel and supply transfers. Surrounding the facility is a single Durasteel wall approximately 20 meters in height and numerous rings of coral beyond the wall.

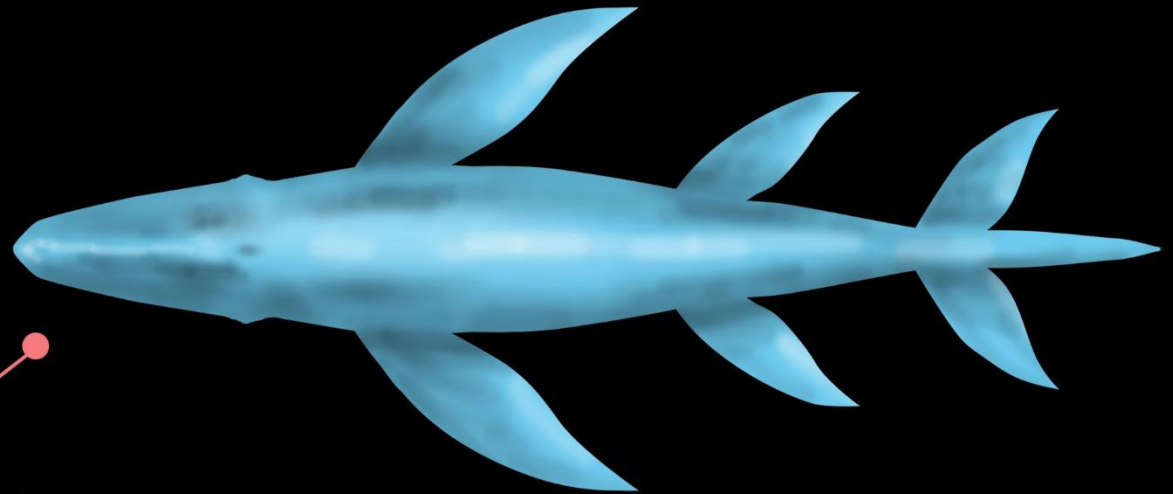
AQUATIC SEA-LIFE

In addition to the various sea life that inhabit the area and the proximity of a reported Leviathan breeding ground close to the facility, the immediate area is home to a multitude of species. Species of note include but are not limited to:

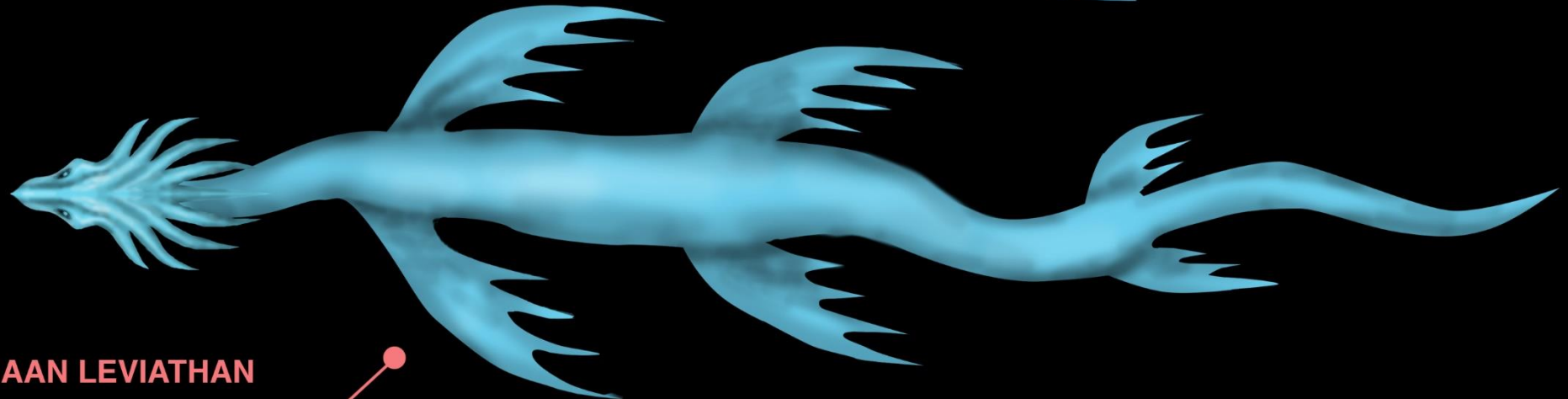
- Nus Whales - while not true “whales,” as they reproduce by laying eggs, these creatures can grow between 80 and 100 meters in length

- Dorumaan Leviathans - large reptilian creatures with life-absorbing capabilities and great speed while underwater

CIVILIAN CASUALTIES MUST BE KEPT AT A MINIMUM

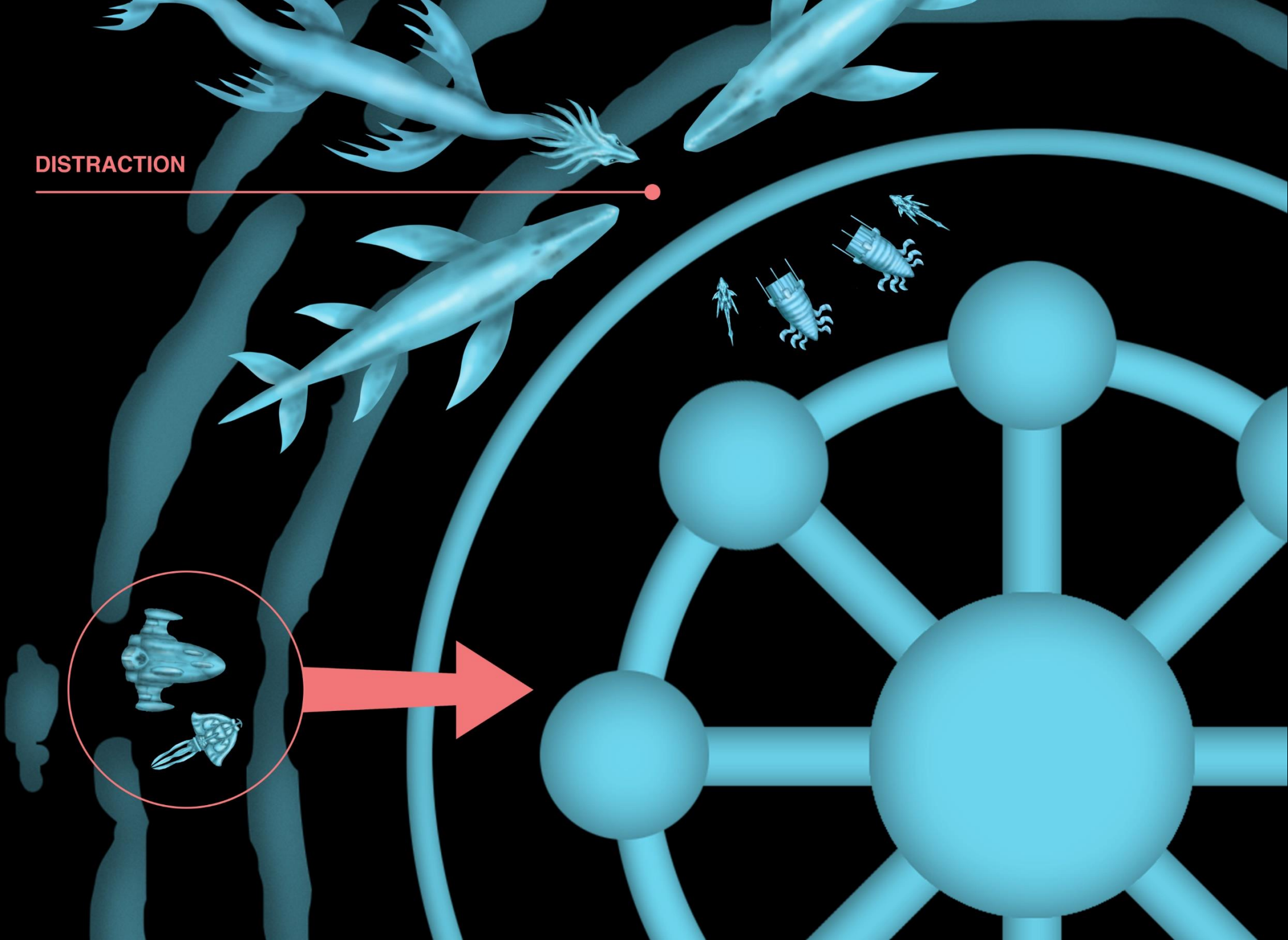
SeNet has been tracking a herd of Nus Whales that will make their closest approach to the facility approximately two days from now. Given what we know of Leviathan behavior, the Nus Whale's proximity to their breeding grounds will cause the Leviathans to become agitated and aggressive.

The single Jedi strike team with Amphibious Fighter escort will move quickly through the coral reef until they are near the perimeter wall. Mystic Gua'lara will utilize her Control Creature ability to draw the Nus Whales closer to the Leviathan breeding grounds. The Leviathans will protect their young by increasing their presence in the immediate area. This will no doubt put the DIG facility on High Alert and force facility defences to deal with the threat. If the distraction could be contained to a single side, this will allow the strike team to use the stealth equipped submarine to traverse the wall.

The escort fighters will remain in the area to cover the strike team during their infil and exfil and must remain hidden to not alert the facility. Once over the wall the Jedi will infiltrate the facility through one of the outer hub's hatches. They will then make their way through the facility and into the central hub. From there they will find the chief scientist and using **NON-LETHAL** METHODS ONLY, learn what they can about the chemical being produced. It will be up to the Jedi to sabotage any and all production equipment to prevent later use as well as secure all relevant material and documents for extraction. The Jedi will make their way back out of the facility and report to Odan-Urr High Command for debriefing.
