History

The Expansionist are a subgroup within the larger criminal syndicate known as the Tenixir Revenants. They stand in opposition to the Retributionists on the future direction of the collective. Expansionists believe in bringing an end to the conflict with the Principate so they can acquire territory in the Outer Rim to truly establish themselves as a regional power while the Retributionist seek only the destruction and dissolution of the Principate as the driving goal for the group.

A Split in the Reavers

The split between the Expansionist and the Retributionist was long in the works as various members and leaders of the criminal group developed different goals and ideals that they believed the group should adopt. Given the independent nature of many of the crews and members of the group it took some time for the various sects to eventually coalesce into the two ideologically opposed camps. These opposing views came to a head with the jailing of First Mate Zyft Yadar.

Jailing of Zyft Yadar

Zyft Yadar was First Mate to Captain Rasha Hawee, making her the closest thing the Revenants had to a second in command. Rasha and Zyft differed starkly on the direction they believed the Revenants should take in the future with Zyft championing what would become the Expansionist cause while Rasha became de-facto leader of the Retributionist. Rasha had Zyft jailed and charged with attempting to incite munity turning what had been mostly an academic debate into a fight for the future destiny of the Revenants. Zyft would break out of her jail cell and flee with the help of Avitus Oligard.

Engaging the Principate

Sending out a call for aid and offering good bounties, many members of the Brotherhood answered the call to join the Expansionist cause, including many members of Clan Vizsla who

saw not only a chance to make some credits but an opportunity to help establish the Revenants as future allies and business partners.

While the Expansionists were key on making peace with the Principate, they understood that they could only achieve that from a position of strength, thus they set out to disrupt Principate operations on Dandoran as well as kidnap leaders of the Principate to serve as bargaining chips in peace negotiations. This culminated in the kidnapping of Kalee Reecchi by an Expansionist strike force led by Malfrost Xeon. This small victory as soon overshadowed though when the Seer unleashed her Crystal Ascendant on the planet.

Chaos on Dandoran

The Seer unleashed her Crystal Ascendant to draw other Brotherhood members who were in the area working for both Revenant and Principate forces. Their arrival on the scene caused mass chaos and resulted in the Principate releasing their Restoration Troopers in response. The result was crystal monstrosities battling it out across Dandoran and on the streets of Tipool.

Evacuation of Tipool

Tipool was overrun with both Crystal Ascendant and Restoration Troopers, with the civilian population being caught in the middle. Realizing that they did not have the military might to match the chaos in the streets the Expansionist shifted to aiding in the evacuation of the city by converting as many of their ships as possible into transports. Saving the people of Tipool would show the galaxy that the Revenant were more than just thugs but competent organizers and leaders capable of running a part of the galaxy themselves. Brotherhood members battled it out against both Crystal Ascendant and Restoration Troopers as well as aiding with the evacuation efforts however they could.

An Uneasy Alliance

Amid all the chaos and destruction, the Expansionist were able to establish communications with the Harmonist, a pro-peace wing within the Principate. Realizing they had more in common with one another than they did with the more belligerent arms of their factions, the two groups established a tentative alliance to not only aid in the evacuation of Tipool and Dandoran as a whole but also to end the conflict between the two factions by either forcing the Retributionists and Restorers to the negotiating table or destroy them to enough of a degree to where the peace factions could assume the leadership of both the Reavers and the Principate. Wither or not this tentative alliance will survive the initial chaos on Dandoran however is yet to be seen.
