The many scattered archipelagos across Aliso give a natural mask for some of the more grisly parts of Clan Plagueis' regime. Sterilization of slaves is not always efficient or effective. In some cases, the property has been known to spawn. The leadership of Clan Plagueis isn't unsympathetic to children that have been sired by the chattel, and have set up an educational program on several of the islands in one archipelago. Each school is responsible for a different style of learning, designed to cater to the abilities and aptitudes of different students. Those with Force potential are segregated for the purpose of training in the Shadow Academy, but those who aren't are raised to be loyal to Clan Plagueis and developed into different parts of Aliso society. Some are raised to be military personnel, some work in architecture, some in engineering.

Some do not show any specific aptitude other than in raw strength. These are grown to work either as military grunts or are returned to the slave pens to work alongside their sires. Some do not show any aptitude whatsoever.

The schools are well built and serve all of the needs of children and adolescents. They are able to grow and thrive as well as any other member of the Aliso citizenry. The islands also serve as natural protective custodians, with only well guarded speeder ports as access between the schools and the mainland; to protect the children.
