

The Aliso City Heights is a large four story building sitting on the border of the residential and warehouse districts of Aliso city. While originally a CIS warehouse, over the years the abandoned building had been taken over by criminals and squatters. In its current state the first three floors of Aliso City Heights are makeshift apartments built from scrounged materials such as scrap wood and steel as well as whatever the residents of the building have brought with them in order to provide a bare minimum of privacy. The fourth floor of the building is used by criminal enterprises to produce, sell and store illegal goods with a handful of old offices used as apartments for the workers making and guarding the illegal goods.

The majority of the Aliso City Heights residents are refugees from off world and those unable to find safe logging elsewhere. All residents of Aliso City Heights are required to pay rent to the gangs who run the upper floors, who in turn give a cut to local authorities to turn a blind eye to the activities within the building. There are currently approximately 300 residents inside the dark, decrepit and ramshackle loggings of Aliso City Heights. Due to the nature of the "apartments", many of the residents do not have access to a window for exterior views or natural light.
