Plan Summary

Statement: This Plan is a defensive oriented plan designed for use in immediate defense of Caelestis City



Purpose

Purpose: This plan fulfills Imperial Scholae Army Planning guidance tasked for developing a comprehensive Level 4 plan to undertake military operations in the defense of threats posed by invading Children of Mortis forces. This objective plan is threefold

1. Establish and maintain vigilant defensive conditions
2. If necessary, conduct operations that will, if directed, defeat Children of Mortis Threats.
3. Aid civil authorities in maintaining law and order, restore basic services during and after the invasion



Conditions for Implementation

Military Situation: Children of Mortis forces are dangerous to civilian, military and Clan forces. With the ability to convert large portions of population to Ascendant this proves detrimental to security, economic, and political activity. These conditions exist at present. Given the rapidity at which Children of Mortis forces can spread, immediate decisive and unilateral military force is required.



Plan Execution

Plan 46/15 — G is designed to be implemented across 6 phases of military operation. When directed by the Emperor or the Viceroy, CSPARMCOM will issue mission type orders to execute specific action against Children of Mortis forces from this plan. This plan is designed to be implemented immediately.

Children of Mortis Threat Summary:

Plan 46/15 — ☐ is designed to address the following Children of Mortis threats

0. Use of Ascension gas by enemy forces.
1. Restoration Troopers
Standard Children of Mortis trooper created by modification with crystals
2. Ascendant Troopers
Elite Children of Mortis Trooper. More capable and autonomous than Restoration troopers.
3. Purified Ascendant
Further refinement of the Children of Mortis Trooper. Extraordinarily dangerous.
4. Crystal Raptors
Saurian hunter-killers modified in the same fashion as Restoration and Ascendant Troopers.
5. Crystal Abberations
Large beasts modified in the same fashion as Restoration and Ascendant Troopers.

6. Modified AT-AP
 First Order artillery piece. Modified with kyber crystal technology.
7. Modified AT-M6
 First Order heavy assault walker. Modified with kyber crystal technology

9. Modified AT-TE
 Clone war era walker. Modified with kyber crystal technology
10. Modified M-2 Tank
 Repulsor Tank. Modified with kyber crystal technology

11. Modified TIE Striker

Galactic Empire Support fighter. Modified with kyber crystal technology

12. Modified Troop Transports

Repulsor Tank. Modified with kyber crystal technology

Environmental Effects

The following environmental effects apply to this plan:

1. Use of Ascension gas against civilian and military populations are limited by effective distribution of aerosolized weapon. Rain and other atmospheric conditions may impact effectiveness.
2. Civilians that are not evacuated from localized enemy deployment zone experience greater risk of casualties and conversion.



Legal Consideration

All legal considerations taken into account apply only to citizens of the Empire. No legal regulation or restriction applies to action against the Children of Mortis.



Phases

Deployment: CSPARMCOM specifies deployment of 1st Imperial Line Regiment to line Aurek, 2nd Imperial line Regiment to line Besh, 3rd Imperial Line Regiment to line Cresh, and 4th Imperial Line Regiment and Praetorian Guard to Line Dorn.

Phases:

1. Shape
2. Deter
3. Seize Initiative
4. Dominate
5. Stabilize
6. Restore



Phases cont'd

1. Shape: CSPARMCOM will conduct operations to establish and shape the battlefield. Including establishing a quaternary defensive perimeter around Adironam tower. Shaping operations limit the area of engagement and limits enemy movement.
2. Deter: CSPARMCOM will conduct operations which prevent further advance of enemy lines.
3. Seize the initiative: CSPARMCOM will initiate force wide counterattacks.
4. Dominate: CSPARMCOM will press offensive, isolating and eliminating enemy forces.
5. Stabilize: CSPARMCOM will conduct operations which reestablish control of Caelestis City to CSPARMCOM. CSPARMCOM will remain combat ready.
6. Restore: CSPARMCOM will remain on station, determining continued enemy threat levels and assist local authority in reestablishing services to civilians. CSPARMCOM will remain combat ready.

Assumptions

1. CSPARMCOM will have situational awareness necessary to conduct all operations
2. Enemy force will grow in strength with casualties.
3. CSPARMCOM forces will degrade as conflict persists
4. There is no known countermeasure for Ascension gas.



Operational Limitations

CSPARMCOM forces must

1. Remain postured to deter enemy aggression
2. Continue to conduct assigned mission and operations throughout all phases of plan.
3. Maintain viable up to date operation plans.
