Auction Item 73 — The Jewel of Amok-Syn

Supposedly one of the earliest creations of ancient Sith Lord Darth Andeddu, the Jewel of Amok-Syn — so-named after the ancient city in which over a hundred citizens were claimed to have been sacrificed in order to empower it on the eve of the Summer solstice — is of a rich cobalt stone, a lattice of golden flecks within its depths. It is marked with two characters that have been filled in with gold; one known and one unknown: 'Midwan', meaning 'Power' in Ancient Sith while the other is a series of flowing characters that have the overall appearance of an eye. It is said to renew the energy of the wielder when grasped and the activation word spoken, though there are believed to be other uses.

This artifact was recovered during an archaeological dig at the <u>Velastari Temple</u>, encased in what appeared to be plaster.
